After our first two weeks of school, our children are settling in very nicely to their new routines, new teachers and new classrooms. Our final enrollment count shows 261 students. In addition to our 37 new Kindergarteners, we've had 20 new students transfer into our school this year.

We have processed all Courtesy Bus applications received to date. Take note, that our BLUE bus route is now full and unless a student moves off that route, no further Courtesy requests for that bus will be approved.

Special note for parents of children who have been approved for a courtesy seat on the blue bus: The District's Courtesy Seat policy notes that if a student moves into the blue bus zone and requires their seat as per their civic address, your child's courtesy seat could be revoked with one week's notice.


Our Breakfast Program Needs Help

Emergency School Closures

As we've already seen very early on this year, school may have to close on a moment's notice for a number of reasons. A few things to remember in that regard:



- You should have an emergency plan in place for where your child will go. Recognizing, however, that even those plans could change unexpectedly, every family will be contacted BEFORE we release the buses.
- It is vital that we keep our telephone lines open for the transmission of emergency information from outside agencies who are working with us to solve the problem.
- You do not need to call the school to give us direction about where your child is going. Your child's teacher will contact you.
- Never leave a voicemail with directions for your child's dismissal, in an emergency closure or otherwise. There is no guarantee that the message will be heard and delivered to your child.
- Upon notification that the school is closing, you may come directly to the school to pick up your child.
- Walkers will not be dismissed until traffic has subsided and the buses have left the parking lot.

Road Construction on Adam Crescent

As construction continues on Adam Crescent, all traffic is diverted to Forest Road. With increased vehicular traffic on this street, we ask that parents and guardians transporting children to school use extreme caution and be sure to obey speed limits.

Boil Order in Effect

The water line break on Adam Crescent caused our water outage last week and has resulted in a boil water order. Water coolers will be placed throughout the school while the boil water advisory is in effect. It would be helpful if your child brought their own refillable water container from home.
